About Our School

Shawsheen Valley is accredited by the New England Association of Secondary Schools and Colleges as a technical high school for grades 9-12 with an enrollment of approximately 1,300. Shawsheen offers a solid academic program and specialized technical instruction in twenty career areas. Eligible seniors can elect to participate in cooperative education to further their understanding of the industry and advance their skills in their field of study.

Our School Community

Shawsheen Valley is a regional technical school district located twenty miles northwest of Boston. The district is composed of five (5) member towns. These towns include Bedford (pop. 14,171), Billerica (pop. 42,683), Burlington (pop. 25,920), Tewksbury (pop. 30,915), and Wilmington (pop. 23,534). The district population is primarily upwardly mobile middle class. With its proximity to Routes 128, 93 and 495, the district lies in the heart of much of Massachusetts' high-tech industry. Students residing in the district have the option of attending the traditional high school in their town or applying to Shawsheen Valley Technical High School to pursue technical study in addition to traditional academic class work.
